

COLONEL HUBERT "HUB" ZEMKE

(1914-1994)

*A devoted Beale Library supporter
and proponent of education.*

Colonel Zemke entered the U.S. Army Air Corps in 1936 and received his wings and commission in 1937.



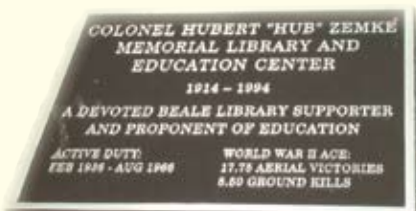
In World War II, Zemke commanded the 56th Fighter Group. Under his leadership and using tactics he taught them, group pilots scored 665.5 air-to-air victories, the most of any fighter group in the war. Zemke himself received credit for 17.75 aerial victories and 8.5 enemy aircraft destroyed on the ground. He later became a German P.O.W. for several months.

In 1957, when the U-2S transferred to the air force at Laughlin AFB, Texas, Colonel Zemke became the 4080th SRW Commander. After his retirement, he lived in Oroville, California. Until his death, he remained active in the Beale AFB Chapter of the Daedaleans and strongly supported the Beale AFB Library.
